

Kendal Museum Wild Art and Photography Competition Terms and Conditions

- 1- The promoter is Kendal Museum whose registered office is at Station Rd, Kendal, LA9 6BT.
- 2- The competition is open to residents of the United Kingdom aged between the years of 4 and 11.
- 3- There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.
- 4- By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- 5- Route to entry for the competition and details of how to enter are via <http://www.kendalmuseum.org.uk>. The competition will also be promoted on social media platforms including Facebook, Instagram and Twitter.
- 6- Only one entry will be accepted per child. Multiple entries from the same child will be disqualified.
- 7- Closing date for entry will be 19/6/21. After this date no further entries to the competition will be permitted.
- 8- No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.
- 9- The rules of the competition and how to enter are as follows:
Create a piece of art work or take a photograph of a wild thing,
Entrants must be between the ages of 4 and 11 years old, submit your artwork either by email to info@kendalmuseum.org.uk or in person at the museum when we are open
- 10- The promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the promoter's control. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by the promoter.
- 11- The promoter is not responsible for inaccurate prize details supplied to any entrant by any third party connected with this competition.
- 12- The prize consists of art supplies suitable for children between the ages of 4 and 11.

The prize is as stated and no cash or other alternatives will be offered. The prizes are not transferable. Prizes are subject to availability and we reserve the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice.

13- Winners will be chosen by an independent adjudicator or panel of judges appointed by the Promoter before 25th December 2021.

14- The winner will be notified through their school. If the winner cannot be contacted or do not claim the prize within 14 days of notification, we reserve the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and pick a replacement winner.

15- The promoter will notify the winner when and where the prize can be collected / is delivered.

16- The promoter's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
